## **Acts 9:1–31**

Saul was breathing threats and murder against the disciples of the Lord. On the road to Damascus, Saul met Jesus and was transformed. How has Jesus transformed you?

### ***Observation: What does it say?***

1. Read Acts 9:1–31 . Mark *God/pronouns, Jesus, Holy Spirit, Saul*.
2. Answer the five Ws and H. Who are the major players? What is happening? When is it happening? Where is it happening? Why is it happening? How is it happening?
3. After Saul regained his sight (Ac 9:18) what things did he do? List them.
4. Why are the disciples afraid to associate with Saul? (Ac 9: 26)  
Who takes him to the disciples and “defends” him?

### ***Interpretation: What does the author mean?***

5. Why was Saul going to Damascus? What did he plan to do there?

6. Why did Ananias hesitate to go to Saul when the Lord was telling him to go? (Ac 9:11ff)

8. Why was Saul “confounding” the Jews in Ac 9:22? Why did they plot against him?
